De conformidad al Artículo 23 de la Ley contra el Financiamiento del Terrorismo, se hace de su conocimiento, la Comunicación **DPPA/SCAD/SCSOB/2024/SCA/2/25 (08)** de fecha 06 de octubre de 2025, enviada por la Misión Permanente de Honduras ante las Naciones Unidas en Nueva York, mediante la cual se informa que el Comité del Consejo de Seguridad de la ONU, establecido en virtud de la resoluciones 1267(1999), 1989(2011) y 2253(2015), relativas a ESIL (Dáesh), Al-Qaida y las personas, grupos, empresas y entidades asociados, el 06/10/2025 el Comité promulgó los cambios a las entradas que figuran en la Lista del Consejo de Seguridad de las personas y entidades a las que se aplicaban sanciones -congelación de activos, la prohibición de viajar y el embargo de armas- establecidos en el párrafo 1 de la resolución 2734 (2041) de dicho consejo.

Se enfatiza que las decisiones del Consejo de Seguridad, del cual Honduras forma parte, deben ser atendidas por todos los Estados Miembros y se solicita informar cualquier hallazgo y/o inquietud, una vez se realicen los registros correspondientes sobre el tema en referencia.
