De conformidad al Artículo 23 de la Ley contra el Financiamiento del Terrorismo, se hace de su conocimiento, la Comunicación **DPPA/SCAD/SCSOB/2025/SCA/2/25 (09)** de fecha 16 de octubre de 2025, enviada por la Misión Permanente de Honduras ante las Naciones Unidas en Nueva York, mediante la cual se informa que el Comité del Consejo de Seguridad de la ONU, establecido en virtud de la resoluciones 1267(1999), 1989(2011) y 2253(2015), relativas a EIIL (Dáesh), Al-Qaida y las personas, grupos, empresas y entidades asociadas, informa que fue modificada la Lista de Sanciones de acuerdo a las entradas que se especifican en los cambios que figuran en la nota precitada y que se adjunta.- Sanciones sujetas a la congelación de activos, la prohibición de viajar y el embargo de armas establecidas en el párrafo 1 de la resolución 2734 (2024) del Consejo de Seguridad y aprobado en virtud del Capítulo VII de la Carta de las Naciones Unidas.

Se enfatiza que las decisiones del Consejo de Seguridad, del cual Honduras forma parte, deben ser atendidas por todos los Estados Miembros y se solicita informar cualquier hallazgo y/o inquietud, una vez se realicen los registros correspondientes sobre el tema en referencia.

On 16/10/2025, the Committee enacted the amendments of the entry specified below on its Sanctions List of individuals and entities subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2734 (2024) and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.
